Shoulder Arthroplasty: from minimal to maximal

Lectures and hands-on sessions (fresh specimen lab):

Lectures will be given by instructors on the indications and results of the different resurfacing prosthesis and the reversed shoulder prosthesis. There is ample time to implant one of these prosthesis on a fresh specimen:

- SR surface replacement: COPELAND RESURFACING shoulder prosthesis (Biomet), TESS resurfacing prosthesis (Biomet), AEQUALIS -resurfacing (Tornier), EPOCA (Synthes), GLOBAL CAP Resurfacing Shoulder Prosthesis (DePuy Johnson & Johnson)
- RP reversed prosthesis: DeltaXtend Reversed Prosthesis (DePuy Johnson & Johnson) AEQUALIS-reversed (Tornier) Anatomical Reversed (Zimmer), Reversed TESS (Biomet)

Elbow Arthroplasty: hemi's, uni's, convertibles and totals!

- Radial head prosthesis (Tornier), Liverpool radial head prosthesis (Biomet)
