Workshop Content

This two-day course is aimed at orthopedic and trauma surgeons with experience in shoulder joint replacement. Predominantly, it is a practical course demonstrating surgical anatomy, approaches etc, but it is also intended to provide further understanding of concepts and biomechanics in shoulder joint replacement, and help the participants to choose the most appropriate implant for each individual patient. The structure of the course involves short lectures, practice on cadaveric specimens and case discussions.
