

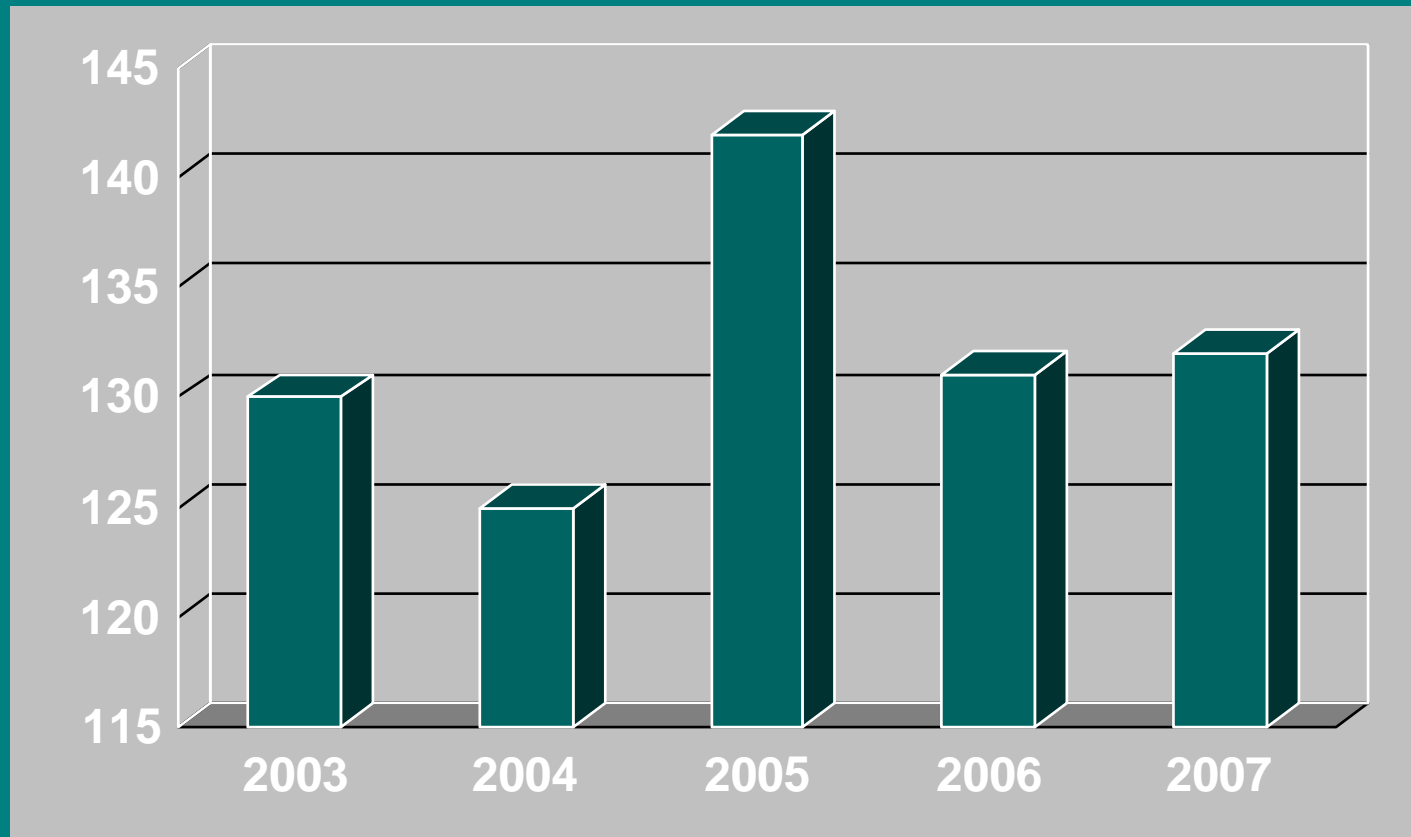

The current situation

- 5 year contract with Elsevier
- 800 - 950 pages per year
- 24 articles per issue - 22 original and 2 review
- Original articles cannot exceed 12 pages
- Case reports cannot exceed 6 pages
- E-publishing
- Current time from acceptance to print average 6 months

- Last year : 460 submissions
- Acceptance rate 34%

- On 16th of September we already have 500 submissions worldwide
- Far exceeds any previous year

- Estimated acceptance rate <25%?
