1. Fellowship

We have organized 3 fellowships: Intra European (Thilo Pazter & Mohamed Moursy), European fellows in Asia (Ali Ersen & Karl Wieser) and US fellows in Europe (Bassem Elhassan & Thomas Throckmorton).

2. SECEC Patronage

Since 2012, the number of demand and acceptance is growing: 4 in 2012 to 20 in 2015. Since last year, we decided to extend the patronage to the National Orthopedic Societies who are willing to develop shoulder and elbow surgery. We provided a 2015 « Vintage Logo » in order to confirm the acceptance of the patronage, which is given by the Education Committee according to the SECEC rules. A 2016 SECEC logo is already ready.



3. SECEC Milano video corner

4. SECEC Cadaver lab

Davide Blonna and Alexander Van Tongel have organized the Cadaver Lab in GHENT on November 2014. It was highly appreciated by the 20 participants for a low price (700€ for 2 days) and will be renewed in November 2015 in GHENT again.

5. SECEC meetings ICL and Symposium program

For the first time in SECEC history, the ICL selection was open to the Ordinary members by simple application on the SECEC Website under precise conditions.

This year each of the 9 ICL have been selected on the 15 applications. One application was submitted by the Education Committee and accepted by the Executive Committee for the Elbow Symposium. We suggest renewing this opening new rule for ICL and Symposium for the next SECEC congress.

6. SECEC meetings: JSES open session

A JSES session, organized together with the Qualification Committee under the chairmanship of Ulrich Brunner is organized for the first time during the Milano Congress. A dedicated letter is published on the SECEC Website. We hope a great success of this new session in which the attendees will have a chance to get evaluation by EBM questions system.

7. SECEC Elbow course

Due to the success of the first Elbow course organized by Samuel Antuna in 2012 in MADRID together with the SECEC closed meeting, a Second Elbow course will be in BELGIUM organized by Denise Eygendaal and Roger Van Riet
